



TRANSPORTATION

Support robust funding for the Florida Department of Transportation’s work plan, emphasizing priority projects impacting the Orlando region, including investing in I-4 Beyond the Ultimate through Moving Florida Forward, expanding Orlando’s regional transit system and strengthening our global gateways through support for our international airports and seaport.

SEMICONDUCTORS

Advance and accelerate existing investments in semiconductor research, development, and manufacturing at Osceola County’s NeoCity, contribute to the nation’s semiconductor reshoring, and establish the Orlando region as the leading semiconductor hub in the southeast United States. Advocate for \$2,950,000 in funding for BRIDG – Microchip Advanced Packaging Design Center through Appropriations request filed by Sen. Jason Brodeur & Rep. Paula Stark

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Support policies and funding that enhance economic opportunities for our region including increased funding for the Job Growth Grant Fund and additional funding for state workforce training programs. Support full funding for Visit Florida.

EDUCATION

Lead the nation in microelectronics, STEM, and healthcare workforce development through supporting the University of Central Florida’s request for \$75 million. Support the adoption of the newly proposed funding models for the region’s State Colleges.

BUSINESS COMPETITIVENESS

Support the Legislature’s tort reform package. Support the continued repeal or reduction of the sales tax imposed on commercial leases. Monitor and oppose harmful private cause of action language associated with any data privacy legislation.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Support renewed focus on and robust funding for Florida’s affordable housing programs, providing local governments, developers, and non-profits the tools to increase supply and enhance attainable and affordable workforce housing opportunities.

HEALTHCARE

Support full funding of Medicaid reimbursement for our local healthcare systems, the enhancement of opportunities to expand the nurse education workforce, and expansion of the mental health services.
