

Certificate of Insurance Requirements

Seminole County



Requirements:

- Commercial General liability coverage: \$1,000,000
 - \$1M each occurrence/\$1M general aggregate.
- Business Auto Policy^{**}: \$1,000,000 combined single limit
 - Coverage shall include Owned, Non-owned, and Hired autos or Any Auto.
 - May be satisfied with appropriate endorsement to General Liability coverage or Hired and Non-owned coverage if production company does not own vehicles.

^{**}Required if using vehicles in the production, or roadways are closed for the production, or vehicles will be staged on right-of-way, or vehicles are on County property.

- Workers compensation insurance^{***} with Statutory Limits and:
 - \$500,000 each accident employer's liability
 - \$500,000 disease each employee
 - \$500,000 disease policy limits

^{***}Required if using County property.

^{***}Student productions where no employees are involved may be exempt from workers' compensation coverage.

^{***}Will accept Volunteer's Insurance in place of WC when applicable. \$500,000 for volunteer medical expenses.

^{***}If a production company claims exemption from workers' compensation insurance, they may submit their Exemption Certificate for consideration. If

approved, only those specifically named in the Exemption Certificate may work on the project.

- Coverage shall apply on a primary and non-contributory basis. Policies shall be endorsed to provide a Waiver of Subrogation clause in favor of Seminole County.
- General liability and Auto policies shall be endorsed to include Seminole County, Florida, its officials, officers, and employees as additional insured.
- The General Liability policy shall be on an occurrence rather than a claims-made basis.
- All carriers shall have and maintain an AM Best's Rating of "A-" or better and a financial size category of VII or better.
- If the production is on Seminole County property, additional insurance requirements may apply and will be determined by Seminole County Risk Management.
- **Indemnification:**
 - [Production Company] and subsidiaries will defend, indemnify and hold harmless Seminole County, Florida their agents and employees from and against all liabilities, claims, damages, losses, costs and expenses (including attorney's fees) arising out of or resulting from the filming of said film, including all persons directly or indirectly employed by them or anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable.
